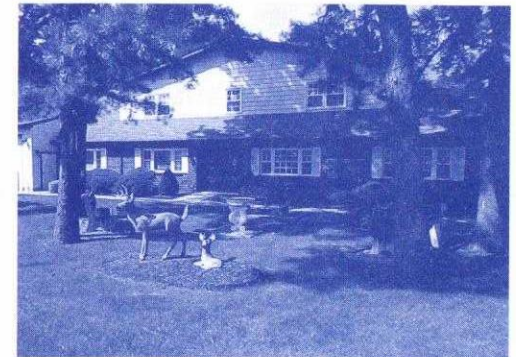

TRANSPORTATION

CARES has four automobiles and
offers **DIAL-A-RIDE** services
where our volunteer drivers will
take residents to almost any
location in Whiting and return
them to their homes.

Call 732-350-2900 to make
your reservation one day in
advance of your planned trip. A
wheelchair van is also available to
transport residents. An able bodied
companion must accompany the
person in the wheelchair.

Another van is available to
transport physical aid equipment
to a persons home if they are not
able to come to **CARES**.

**Wheelchairs, walkers,
crutches, canes, cots and
other aids are available free
on a loaner basis.**
